On this date, The Philadelphia Protestant Home (PPh) was incorporated in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, our Charter was granted, and we welcomed our first resident, Maria Magdalena Seitz.

Over the more than 12 decades since PPh's humble beginning, we have steadily expanded our services and amenities to better meet the needs of the residents in our senior living community. Today, PPh offers Independent Living, Personal Care, and Skilled Nursing and Rehabilitation options with access to numerous programs for our residents — all under one roof and all at an affordable cost.

The Bergdoll Society was established to recognize individuals and organizations who have given \$500 or more in the previous calendar year. The Society is named for Elizabeth Bergdoll, who bequeathed \$15,000 in 1898 to purchase the land that PPh occupies today.

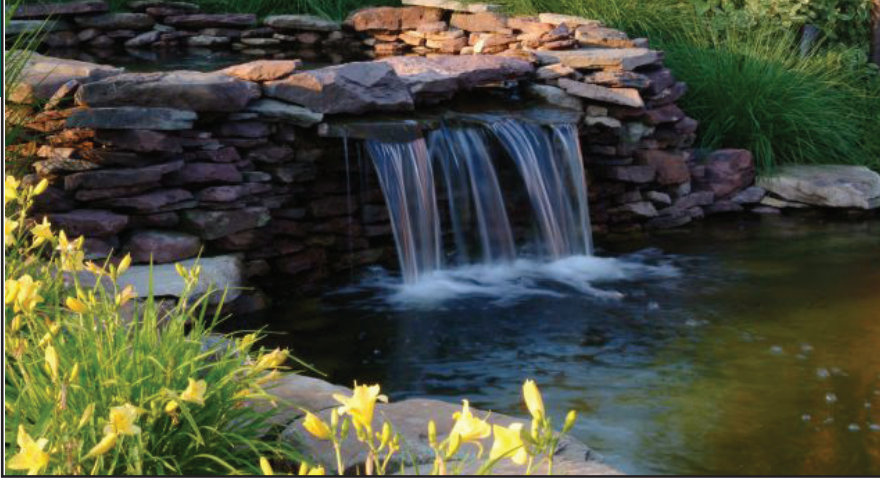

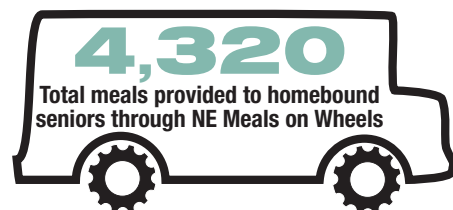

- Programs, events, and services designed to enhance the well-being of our neighbors in Northeast Philadelphia and beyond
- Financial contributions to make a positive economic impact in our community, including charitable gifts and affordable housing for low-income seniors
- Volunteer work and community service projects performed by our residents and staff
- Grassroots advocacy on behalf of older adults at the local, state, and federal levels

2015 Community Benefit Highlights

All of us in the PPh family take great pride in our tradition as a mission-based, long-term care provider and in our ability to make an impact today — and for many generations to come. In 2015, we partnered with others to promote the well-being of the community by:

Karl Loewe, 87, has no problem keeping busy and enjoying his retirement lifestyle at The Philadelphia Protestant Home (PPh). Karl is a 14-year resident of Gateway Manor, one of the three independent living apartment homes at PPh.

"There is so much going on here at PPh every day, and I like that we have so many choices," he says.

Karl shares that he also enjoys the variety of dining options, such as sitting down to a hot meal in the dining room or enjoying a sweet treat from the Scoops ice cream shop. Some of his favorite independent living activities include the summer concert series; tai chi classes, which are held every Wednesday afternoon; and strolling around the walking path that encircles the beautifully landscaped and secure PPh campus.

When Karl first moved to PPh, he and his late wife lived together in their independent living apartment for three years, until Mrs. Loewe required more specialized care in PPh's supportive memory care environment due to her advancing Alzheimer's disease.

"That was the best care she ever could have received. I still feel very grateful that she could get the excellent and compassionate care that she did at PPh," says Karl, who has been a valued member of The Heritage Society of The Philadelphia Protestant Home since 2002.

Membership in the Heritage Society is reserved for individuals who have remembered PPh in their will or made a deferred gift such as a charitable gift annuity.

"PPh has been so good to me and my wife, so I decided to make a planned gift, because I want to be good to them. The bottom line is kindness. There is so much kindness here from both the staff and the residents. I just love it at PPh, and I doubt I would feel the same way in another retirement home," Karl says.

- Providing internships in Recreational Therapy
- Inviting the community to attend free educational sessions on aging, concerts, veteran events, and social activities
- Donating food, clothing, furniture, and household items to various charitable organizations
- Ministering to the diverse spiritual needs of all residents and others in the community
- Offering intergenerational programs, including a summer camp and a tutoring program with a local elementary school
- Conducting two Red Cross blood drives, resulting in the collection of 34 pints of donated blood
- Providing the site for the Cedar Grove Elementary School disaster drill
- Employees donating 40 turkeys to the Sunday Breakfast Rescue Mission Thanksgiving turkey drive
- Providing professionally guided services to resident and community veterans and their families to assist with and expedite the application process for veterans' benefits
- Providing \$2,100 in healthcare education tuition assistance to three employees of PPh through the Eberhard and Helen Schea Endowment Fund for Healthcare Education.

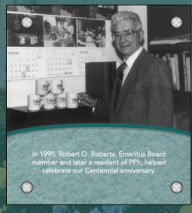

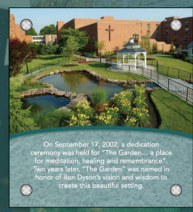
In 1990, Robert O. Roberts, Emeritus Board member and past president of PPH, helped celebrate our Centennial anniversary.

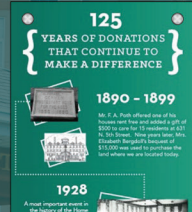
The September of 1998, former PPH President Ron Dymon and current President Andrew Marston, along with local politicians and staff, cut the ceremonial ribbon during the grand opening of Parkway, a 150-bed assisted care and skilled nursing and rehabilitation center. This facility replaced Wade Pavilion, which underwent major renovations in 1999 resulting in 25 private, personal care rooms on the second floor and our Chairman unit on the third floor for residents with early stage dementia.



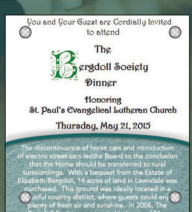
On September 17, 2002, a dedication ceremony was held for "The Garden," a place for meditation, healing and remembrance. "The Garden" was named in honor of Ron Dymon's vision and wisdom to create this beautiful setting.



In 1923, the Rev. Henry Smith, Chairman of the Long Range Planning Committee, introduced and passed a resolution to the Board for future expansion. A two-phase plan to include the new concept of independent living apartments and a building for 132 private care residents was presented and passed. The groundbreaking for Gateway Manor and Midway Manor was held on October 6, 1925, marking the 82nd anniversary of PPH.



In 1928, a most important event in the history of the Home was the gift from the Goodwill Society of \$15,000 used to purchase the land where we are located today.
