

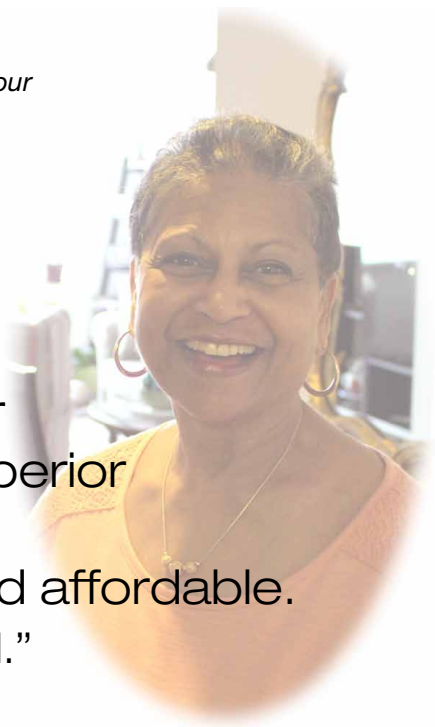

## We are home....

- Personal Care at PPH is best suited for residents who require a helping hand with their medications and daily living activities such as bathing, dressing and grooming. The Personal Care setting at PPH offers private accommodations with powder rooms and other home-like amenities, as well as escorts to the private dining rooms and life-enrichment activities.

In addition, we have nurses and certified nursing assistants on site 24 hours a day, seven days a week for your assurance. Every Personal Care resident has a coordinated care plan tailored to his or her specific needs.



- PPH's Memory Care program provides a higher level of personalized and compassionate care to residents with cognitive impairments due to Alzheimer's Disease, and other forms of memory loss. Memory Care is offered in a secured living environment and delivered by compassionate caregivers who are specially trained to recognize and respect the physical, social and spiritual needs of our residents.

Memory Care also includes specially designed recreational activities and monthly support group meetings for family members.



- Pathways Skilled Nursing and Rehabilitation Center rated among the Best Nursing Homes by U.S. News & World report four years in a row. Pathways offers our residents short-term rehabilitative care after a hospital stay or a surgical procedure, as well as 24-hour long-term nursing care in a positive and stimulating environment.

Services and amenities also include a recreation therapy program, nutrition management by a registered dietitian, a restorative care program, home-like family centers and lounges, pastoral care and social services.

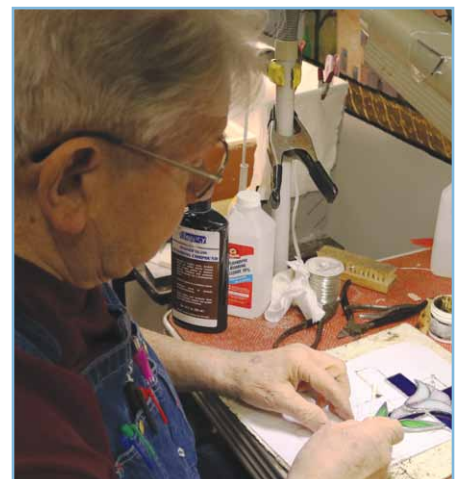

# Community Benefit

## Taking Care and Giving Back

As a nonprofit senior living community, PPH takes great pride in our commitment to reinvesting our resources to improve the well-being not only of residents, but also the larger community.

PPH's comprehensive community benefit program, without financial incentive, focuses on five key areas of need: social accountability, financial assistance, health and wellness, community support, and training and education.

The entire PPH Family takes great pride in our tradition as a mission-based, long-term care provider and in our ability to make an impact today — and for many generations to come. In 2016, we partnered with others to promote the well-being of the community in the following areas:

### Social Accountability

- Providing housing and services for more than 600 residents and many members of the community.
- Providing affordable housing to low-income residents of the community.
- Providing home and community-based services through the Bridge to Care program to seniors who wish to remain in their homes.
- Providing 5,503 meals through NE Meals on Wheels to seniors in our community.
- Assisting hundreds of seniors regain maximum independence during their stay in Pathways Skilled Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, enabling them to return to their own homes.
- Offering respite and dementia care as part of our Personal Care program.

- Donating food, clothing, furniture, and household items to various charitable organizations.
- Ministering to the diverse spiritual needs of all residents and others in the community.
- Coordinating employee donations of 40 turkeys for the Sunday Breakfast Rescue Mission Thanksgiving turkey drive.

### Financial Assistance

- Providing meaningful employment for 653 people, who paid \$554,188 in city wage taxes and \$410,353 in state taxes in 2016.
- Providing \$615,573 in Benevolent Care, which supports residents who outlived their financial resources and are no longer able to afford their cost of care. The need for Benevolent Care increases each year by 8 to 10 percent.

- Providing a site for the Cedar Grove Elementary School disaster drill.

## Training and Education

- Serving as a training site for medical students, registered nurses, licensed practical nurses, special education students, area high school students and other future health care professionals.
- Providing two senior internships in recreational therapy to Temple University students, who each completed 600 hours of training.
- Promoting volunteerism to residents, staff and members of the community. In 2016, approximately 250 volunteers, including residents, community members, high school students and college interns gave nearly 390,000 hours of community service.
- Inviting the community to attend free educational sessions on aging, Alzheimer's disease and low vision and hearing loss support groups, summer concerts, veterans' events and social activities.
- Providing professionally guided services to resident and community veterans and their families to assist with and expedite the application process for veterans' benefits.
- Providing \$2,250 in health care education tuition assistance for three PPH employees through the Eberhard and Helen Schea Endowment Fund for Healthcare Education.
- Awarding the 2016 Philadelphia Protestant Home Scholarship to a student at St. John's University in New York City. The scholarship provides \$1,000 to support the continued education and career development of future generations of leaders in senior living.
